**Ian Choy re-elected as President (2026-2027) of
The Hong Kong Institute of Human Resource Management (HKIHRM)**

The Hong Kong Institute of Human Resource Management (HKIHRM) successfully held its 33rd Annual General Meeting (AGM) on 16 July 2026, at which the new Executive Council for the 2026–2027 term was established. Mr. Ian Choy was re-elected as the President of the Institute, and will lead the new leadership team in driving the long-term development of HR professionalism in Hong Kong.

Mr. Choy has been actively involved with the Institute since 2019. He served as Vice President from June 2022 and was elected President in 2025. He brings over 20 years of cross-industry HR management experience, spanning sectors including property, financial services, and the restaurant industries. He is currently an Executive Director responsible for People and Culture, Corporate Communications and Administration at Gammon Construction Limited. He has previously worked at McDonald's and Jardine Group, accumulating extensive practical experience in strategic talent management. Under his leadership, the Institute continues to strengthen its support for HR practitioners, while actively promoting professional exchanges and capability enhancement across different industries.

The newly formed Council also announced the re-election of the Vice Presidents for the 2026–2027 term: Mr Peter Leung, Ms Theresa Lui, Mr Andy Luk. In addition, Mr Peter Leung will serve as Honorary Treasurer. Mr. Charles Ho was also elected as a new Council member. The Council comprises 15 experienced professionals from a wide range of fields, including business organisations, public institutions, public utilities, HR consultancy firms, and the legal sectors. Drawing on their diverse expertise and rich experience, they will provide strategic guidance for the Institute's development.

Mr Choy expressed his gratitude for being re-elected and thanked all Executive Council members for their trust and support. He said, "Taking up the role of President again is not only an acknowledgement of our past work, but also a renewed commitment to our members and the industry. Looking ahead, the Institute will continue to strengthen its position as a leader in the HR profession, creating greater value for members through innovative services and high-quality professional programmes. We will further deepen collaboration with the Government and all stakeholders, helping raise the standard of the HR profession, empower practitioners in a more comprehensive manner, and contribute to positioning Hong Kong as an international talent hub." He added, "In the face of the powerful waves of digital transformation and technological



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innovation, the Executive Council will lead the Institute to move with the times and actively promote an innovative mindset so that the HR profession continues to rise.”

The Institute would like to extend its sincere appreciation to the outgoing Executive Council members for their contributions over the past term. The Institute also thanks all members who attended the Annual General Meeting and continues to receive their steadfast support.
